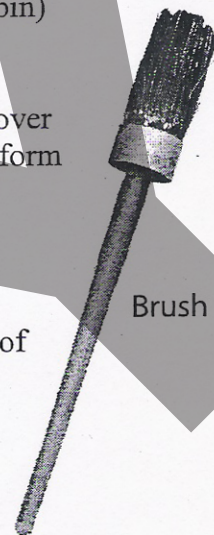


Degreasing a Screen

1. **Write your name on your screen.** Place a piece of masking tape on the edge of your screen and write your name on it.
2. **Wet the screen.** Lift the red handle to turn the water on and make the entire screen wet.
3. **Spray three sprays of degreaser** (the red nozzle spray bottle from the off white bin) on the screen.
4. **Brush the screen.** Use the round wooden, handled brush to spread the degreaser over the screen. Brush the whole screen top to bottom and left to right. Bubbles should form while brushing. Flip the screen to the other side and repeat the brushing.
5. **Rinse the screen.** Turn the water back on and wash off all the degreaser.
6. **Dry the screen.** Cover the counter in paper towels and then lay the screen on top of them fabric side down. Using another paper towel blot the screen until it is dry. If necessary, fan the screen for a moment.



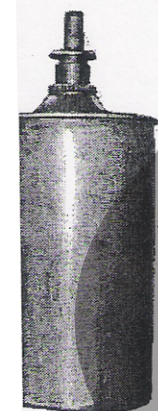

Adhering a Stencil

1. **Make sure the screen is dry.**
2. **Place the stencil,** emulsion (dull) side up, on the countertop.
3. **Lay the screen, fabric side down, on top of the film.** Make sure the stencil is in the middle of the screen. If necessary, move the film to make sure that it is as close to the center as possible.
4. **Clamp down the edges of the screen** using the orange clamps.
5. **Prop open the door and turn on the exhaust fan** to ventilate the room.
6. **Saturate a rag** with adhesive.
7. Using firm **pressure** and the **saturated rag, apply the adhesive**, one swipe at a time. After one application (or stroke), use a second dry rag to remove the excess adhesive. Continue adhering until the entire stencil is adhered.
8. **Put materials away.**
9. **Allow 15 minutes** for the stencil to dry and then slowly peel the clear plastic from the back of the stencil. If any emulsion (green plastic) sticks to clear plastic, stop immediately and let the instructor know.
