

Rubric Criteria for Multi-color Silkscreen Evaluation

Design/Art:

Excellent - Four colors. Art has high degree of difficulty, fine lines, requires critical registration over all of the design,

Good - Three or four colors. Art has average degree of difficulty, medium lines, requires close registration over most of the design.

Fair - Two or three colors. Art has less than average degree of difficulty, medium to wide lines, close registration not involved throughout the design.

Print Quality:

Excellent - All the ink lay down area is opaque and uniformly smooth, free of noticeable spots or smudges.

Good - Most of the ink lay down area is opaque and uniformly smooth, slightly noticeable spots or smudges.

Fair - Several noticeable spots or smudges which interfere with the opaque or uniformly smooth lay of the ink.

Registration —

Excellent - All printed colors lining up in register with joining colors without revealing the background paper between them.

Good - Most printed colors lining up with only minimal spots out of register with background paper color showing less than 1/16".

Fair - Several spots out of register with paper color showing more than 1/16".

Trimming:

Excellent - Adequate and equal borders on trimmed print. Must be trimmed square and to designed trim box size without trim lines showing on smooth straight edges.

Good - Adequate and equal borders on trimmed print. Must be trimmed square and close to designed trim box size with minimal evidence of trim lines showing on the edges.

Fair - Adequate borders on trimmed print. Close to trimmed square and close to trim box size. Minor evidence of trim lines showing at edges.

Mounting:

Excellent - Mounting must be square, of adequate size with borders as instructed (sides and top the same and more space at the bottom). No register marks, glue or smudges showing. Print must be pressed smooth and completely adhered to the mounting board. Name and information on back and legible.

Good - Mounting must be close to square, of adequate size with borders close to proportions as instructed (sides and top the same and more space at the bottom). Slight indication of register marks, glue, smudges, etc. Edges or corners of print could be slightly loose. Name and information on back and legible.

Fair - Mounting must be close to square but not conforming to instructions. Some mounting register marks are showing, glue and/or smudges are evident. Edges or corners of print noticeably loose. Name and information on back and legible.
